The Canadian Child Health Clinician Scientist Program (CCHCSP) is requesting applications from qualified clinician scientists for the position of Selection Committee Member. Selection Committee Members play a critical role in training the next generation of child health clinician scientists in Canada.

CCHCSP is a large volunteer network of research professionals founded in 2002 to support the development of child health clinician researchers across Canada. We partner with 17 pediatric centres in Canada to provide funding, career development training and mentorship for future leaders in child health research. Our trainees include nurses, physicians, occupational therapists, dieticians, psychologists, surgeons, speech language pathologists, among others. Our collective goal is to improve the lives of patients and families, and to make a difference in one child and every child in Canada and beyond.

The successful candidates will be clinician scientists in one of the following clinical disciplines (OT, PT, RN, SLP, RD, SW, Midwifery) and/or be located at one of our partnered centers in BC, AB, SK, MB, NB, PEI, NS, or NL. The candidates will have an established record of academic leadership, a nationally recognized program of grant-funded research in child health, and a commitment to training child health researchers.

The responsibilities of Selection Committee Members involve reviewing around 4 grants in November and April, two 3 hour telecoms in December and May, two in-person interview days in January and June, and attendance at the annual symposium for annual evaluations of our trainees in one on one, in-person meetings.
